This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

Mixing Instructions

Apron MAXX RTA is especially formulated for on-farm treatment, using standard mechanical slurry or mist-type seed treatment equipment which accurately measures and mixes a flowable seed treatment. The equipment must provide uniform coverage of Apron Maxx RTA on the seed. Uneven seed coverage may not give the desired level of disease control. The product does not require the addition of water for this application. Consult the manufacturer of the application equipment you plan to use for suitability for this application and for instructions on operation and calibration of the equipment. Do not mix Apron MAXX RTA with other pesticides unless sufficient compatibility, loading rates, and crop safety factors are determined.

For Dry Peas Seed Treatment – Apron MAXX RTA provides protection against damping-off and seed rots due to *pythium*, *phytophthora*, *Fusarium*, *Rhizoctonia* spp., and early season *phytophthora* root rot. ApronMAXX RTA also also suppresses seed-borne *Sclerotinia* and *phomopsis* spp. For these diseases, Apron MAXX RTA is applied at 5.0 fl. oz. per 100 lbs. of seed.

Seed Labeling: Treated seed must be labeled in accordance with the U.S. Seed Act as follows:

This seed has been treated with Apron MAXX RTA at the manufacturer's recommended rate. Do not use for food, feed or oil purposes. Store away from feeds and foodstuffs.

Use with an EPA-approved dye which imparts an unnatural color to the seed.

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste material.
