#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

---

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Follow all applicable directions, restrictions, Worker Protection Standard requirements, and precautions on the EPA-registered Touchdown CT label.

This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of application.

#### **Recommended Application:**

**Crop:** Flax (excluding flax grown for seed)

**Broadcast Application:** Ground or aerial

Apply 0.75 to 2.2 quarts per acre in 3-15 gals. of water as a broadcast spray over the top for control of labeled weeds.

#### **Spot Application:**

Use a 2% solution on actively growing weeds. Apply until uniformly wet but not to the point of runoff. A 2% solution can be made by mixing 1.5 pints of Touchdown CT in 10 gallons of water.

**Timing:** Apply Touchdown CT only to fully mature flax when the grain moisture is less than 30% and close to harvest.

**General Use Precautions:**

- Do not exceed one application per year for this use.
- Make application at least seven days before harvest.
- There are no rotational crop restrictions following Touchdown CT application.
- When making aerial applications, do not exceed 0.75 quart/A.
- Do not apply to flax grown for seed.
- Do not apply through any irrigation system.
