This Disinfectant Spray is a general purpose disinfectant/deodorant that is Bactericidal, Tuberculocidal, Fungicidal, and Virucidal*. The broad spectrum germicidal efficacy of this Disinfectant Spray has been established with a ten (10) minute contact time at 25 degrees Celsius, against the following organisms:
BACTERICIDAL: Mycobacterium tuberculosis, Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, and Pseudomonas aeruginosa.

•VIRUCIDAL: HIV-1 (AIDS Virus), Herpes Simplex Virus (Type 2), Influenza A2 (Hong Kong), Avian influenza virus, Avian bronchitis virus, Avian laryngotracheitis virus, Hog cholera virus, and Pseudorabies virus on hard, nonporous, inanimate surfaces.

FUNGICIDAL: Trichophyton mentagrophytes pathogenic fungi. This Disinfectant Spray can be used to clean and disinfect floors, benches, and other hard, nonporous surfaces commonly found in bathrooms, shower rooms, and locker rooms.

GENERAL USES

An effective disinfectant on hard, nonporous, inanimate surfaces and objects such as bed frames, desks, tables, chairs, file cabinets, countertops, door handles, walls, sinks, floors, light switch covers, linen carts, telephones, waste containers, hampers, exterior bowl surfaces and exterior urinal surfaces. DO NOT USE ON POLISHED WOOD FURNITURE OR RAYON FABRICS.

NOTE: This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant / high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake well before using.

As a DEODORANT: Hold the can upright, then spray toward the center of the room for 3 to 5 seconds.

As a MILDREW PREVENTATIVE: Spray surface until moist. Don't use on polished wood furniture or rayon fabrics.
As a DISINFECTANT: Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Hold the can upright 6 to 8 inches from the surface. Saturate all surfaces with the recommended disinfecting solution, allowing to remain wet for 10 minutes before wiping, if wiping is required.

***KILLS HIV-1 ON PRE-CLEANED ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES/OBJECTS PREVIOUSLY SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS** in health care settings or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids, and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) (associated with AIDS).
