DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For best results follow a weekly routine with the BAQUACIL® System or BAQUACIL CDX™ System. Consult with your Authorized BAQUACIL Dealer for advice on the system that best suits your pool and your lifestyle. Take a pool water sample to your Authorized BAQUACIL Dealer regularly for a detailed water analysis.

BAQUACIL Premium Algicide for Persistent Algae is used to control the growth of algae in recreational water systems such as pools. For optimum results, systems containing heavy algae growth should be cleaned prior to using BAQUACIL Premium Algicide for Persistent Algae.

For swimming pools having algae growth:

- Add 30 fluid ounces of BAQUACIL Premium Algicide for Persistent Algae per 10,000 gallons of water.
- Run filter continuously for 24 to 48 hours.
- Brush sides and bottom of pool daily until algae growth is eliminated.
- If algae growth is still present after 7 days, repeat treatment.

BAQUACIL Premium Algicide for Persistent Algae is not compatible with chlorine. Do not mix BAQUACIL Premium Algicide for Persistent Algae with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

FIRST AID:

IF INHALED: • Move person to fresh air. • If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. • Call a poison control center doctor for further treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: • Take off contaminated clothing. • Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 - 20 minutes. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: • Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: • Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. • Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. • Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. • Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. • Avoid alcohol.

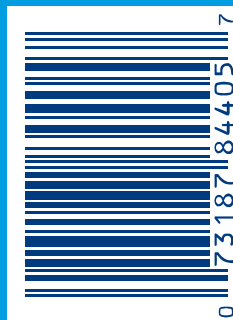
