## General Information

---

**Chemigation:** **DO NOT** apply this product through any irrigation system unless the labeling for chemigation is followed. Refer to the Dual MAGNUM label (EPA Reg. No. 100-816) for use directions for chemigation.

Dual MAGNUM will not control emerged weeds. For effective weed control, Dual MAGNUM must be applied to clean-tilled soil.

## Peppers (Bell and Non-Bell)

---

Apply as a surface broadcast application with ground application equipment prior to transplanting, a broadcast application within 48 hours after transplanting peppers (bell and non-bell), or to direct seed peppers (bell and non-bell) at the eight-leaf stage. Use 0.50 to 1.0 pint (0.48 to 0.95 lb. a.i.) per acre according to soil type. Use lower rates on coarse, sandy soils and higher rates on silt and clay soils. (See product label for more specific information on soil types.)

### Notes:

- (1) **DO NOT** incorporate.
- (2) Use lower rates when sprinkler irrigation is used.
- (3) Muck soils normally require the higher use rate (1.0 pint per acre), however, weed control may be reduced on muck soils.
- (4) To avoid illegal residues, make only one application of Dual MAGNUM per growing season, and **DO NOT** apply within 60 days of harvest.
