Use lower rate on coarse and higher rate on medium or fine textured soils (See product label for more specific information on soil texture).  Not recommended on muck soils due to probable poor weed control.

For irrigated spinach: Irrigate with sprinkler or furrow irrigation within two days of Dual MAGNUM<sup>®</sup> application.

**Precautions and Restrictions:** (1) **DO NOT** incorporate. (2) **DO NOT** apply this product through any type of irrigation system.
