General Information

Grain Sorghum Grown for Forage and Grain

Apply in a minimum of 10 gals. of water per acre with ground equipment or 2 gals. of water per acre by air. Up to 3 applications may be made on a 10-14 day schedule. The number of applications will be determined by the severity of the infestation.

Banks Grass Mite, Sorghum Greenbug: Apply 2 pts./A.

Precaution: Application may result in phytotoxicity to certain sorghum varieties. This phytotoxicity is a temporary spotting, reddening, or chlorosis of the leaves.

Note: To avoid illegal residues, do not apply within 30 days of harvesting or feeding to livestock.
